Quebec Trail Permit:

The procedure for obtaining a trail permit has changed. We no longer have booklets of passes to fill out for you.
ALL permits are only sold online.

The trail permit can only be purchased by the registered owner of the snowmobile; an account must be created in his/her name. Accepted online payment methods: VISA or Master Card

The transaction is carried out on a secure site and no information related to your credit card will be retained once the transaction is complete.

Step 1 – go to <https://fcmq.qc.ca/en/trail-permit/line-trail-permits/>

Step 2 – click on “But a trail permit”, then create an account

Step 3 – provide year, make, model, plate number & VIN of snowmobile, click “buy permit”

Step 4 – in box asking for club number enter **201 (excellent snowmobile club)**

Step 5 – find enhanced sled icon on map below and click on it

Step 6 – pick season, weekly or daily permit

Step 7 – provide credit card information, click purchase

Step 8 – save & print temporary pass for use before permit arrives

Step 9 - receive trail pass (for USA buyers, plan on arrival in 3 weeks)

Sled condition – Your snowmobile must be properly prepared for the trip. BVSA will provide a checklist of items to be serviced prior to the trip. Bringing an unprepared sled is not fair to others.

BVSA recommends that you have a medevac policy for the tour. <https://www.airmedic.net/en/>

BVSA strongly recommends that you purchase travel insurance to protect yourself in the event you cancel trip.

Important: You are participating in an adventure trip with risks and uncertainties, including but not limited to; adverse weather conditions, snow and trail conditions, mechanical malfunction of equipment and unforeseen events both natural and man-made. If it is your desire to remain in control at all times, you are most likely not suited for this type of trip.

Legal stuff:

You will not join the trip if you are experiencing symptoms of Covid.

You no longer must be vaccinated to enter Canada (October 2022). Subject to change.

A previous criminal conviction, including DWI, DUI may result in denied entry in to Canada.

You agree to pay all costs to collect monies due BVSA including reasonable attorney’s fees and court costs.

Alcohol – You agree not to consume ANY alcohol before riding a sled on our trips. If you violate our zero-tolerance policy at any time, you will have, without further notice from BVSA, automatically removed yourself from the tour. If you cannot abstain from having a beer with lunch, please do not join our tour. _____ Customer initial

BVSA may cancel or modify a trip due to conditions and issue a refund to clients. If the trip is extended due to events, you agree to pay the daily rate for additional day/days.

To ensure the safety of the group, the trip guide reserves the right to expel from the trip any person or persons engaging in behavior the guide deems to be disruptive or unsafe. There are no refunds in this case and the expelled party is responsible for the costs of returning to point of origin.

Terms and Conditions:

A deposit of \$500.00 per person is required to reserve trip. The deposit is ONLY refundable if BVSA cannot deliver the agreed upon trip.

PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT, RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

In consideration of the services of Bon Voyage Snow Adventures, their agents, owners, officers, volunteers, employees, and all other persons or entities acting in any capacity on their behalf (hereinafter collectively referred to as "BVSA"), I hereby agree to release, indemnify, and discharge BVSA, on behalf of myself, my spouse, my children, my parents, my heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate as follows:

1. I acknowledge that my participation in guided snowmobile activities entails known and unanticipated risks that could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to myself, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. _____ initial

The risks include, among other things: riding on uneven snow covered terrain; changing snow conditions and variations in elevations; loss of control of the snowmobile; falls from the snowmobile; passengers can be jolted, jarred, bounced, thrown about and otherwise shaken during rides; collision with other snowmobiles, participants, trees, rocks, and other manmade or natural obstacles; snowmobiles are slippery when wet and accident can occur while getting on and off; pinches, bruises, abrasions, strains, burns, cuts and lacerations; exhaustion; major injuries are a risk as are musculoskeletal injuries including head, neck, and back injuries; injuries to internal organs; the negligence of participants, or other persons who may be present; steepness of slopes, snow depth, instability of snow pack or varying and difficult weather; exposure to temperature and weather extremes which could cause hypothermia, frostbite, frostnip, hypoxia, sunburn, or dehydration; encounters with animals and wildlife; altitude sickness, high altitude pulmonary edema; exposure to potentially dangerous wild animals, insect bites, and hazardous plant life; further, passengers can be thrown off the vehicle which can result in any of the above events occurring; transmissible pathogen or disease; accidents or illness can occur in remote places without medical facilities and emergency treatment or other services rendered; equipment failure and mechanical and/or equipment problems; accidents or illness can occur in remote places without medical facilities; improper lifting or carrying; my own physical condition, and the physical exertion associated with this activity. _____ initial

Furthermore, BVSA personnel have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are not infallible. They might be unaware of a participant's fitness or abilities. They might misjudge the weather or other environmental conditions. They may give incomplete warnings or instructions, and the equipment being used might malfunction. _____ initial

2. I expressly agree and promise to accept and assume all of the risks existing in this activity. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate in spite of the risks. I agree to wear a properly fitted and secured DOT or SNELL certified helmet while participating in this activity. _____ initial

3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless BVSA from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action, which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity or my use of BVSA's equipment or facilities, **including any such claims which allege negligent acts or omissions of BVSA.** _____ initial

4. Should BVSA or anyone acting on their behalf, be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs. _____ initial

5. I certify that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may cause or suffer while participating, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further certify that I am willing to assume the risk of any medical or physical condition I may have. _____ initial

6. In the event that I file a lawsuit against BVSA, I agree to do so solely in the state of Connecticut and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply in that action without regard to the conflict of law rules of that state. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining document shall remain in full force and effect. _____ initial

By signing this document, I acknowledge that if anyone is hurt or property is damaged during my participation in this activity, I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against BVSA on the basis of any claim from which I have released them herein. I also agree that this document is valid for subsequent visits and participation at BVSA. I have had sufficient opportunity to read this entire document. I have read and understood it, and I agree to be bound by its terms.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR REFUSAL AGREEMENT

We realize that we are subject to injury from this activity and that no form of preplanning can remove all of the danger to which we are exposing ourselves. Against the advice of BVSA, the guide/instructor, numerous court cases and BVSA's insurance company, we are refusing this critical safety precaution. I also understand that minors are not allowed to refuse protective headgear and I cannot sign in their behalf to waive the requirement.
