ARRIVE: Vieux Moulin

Arrive at the Vieux Moulin located in Sainte Émélie-de-L'Énergie between 3-5 pm. After check in you have some time to yourself to deal with any last minute concerns. We recommend removing your sled from trailer. Meet and greet in lounge at 6pm followed by dinner as a group. Review of safety and security procedures.

DAY 1: Vieux Moulin/Duhamel

Breakfast at the inn. If necessary, pick up any sled rentals next to hotel. First order is to get outside of town, after which we are riding through the mountains. This is a section of trail that is very wide with sweeping turns. A great place to exercise your right thumb if you wish. Four course dinner at Auberge Couleurs de France

Lodging: Auberge Couleurs de France

Distance: 131 miles



DAY 2: Duhamel/Rabaska

Breakfast at the inn. We head north and stop at the popular Devils Mountain. There are great views at the top. It gets more and more remote as the day progresses. Really nice photo opportunities this afternoon. Cabin lodging and a spectacular dinner at the Pourvoirie Rabaska

Lodging: Pourvoirie Rabaska

Distance: 136 miles



DAY 3: Rabaska/Meekoos

Breakfast. This day is spent in the nature of Quebec. Trails and scenery can't get any better than this. Dinner and night is at an "off grid" outfitter with a delicious meal.

Lodging: Meekoos Distance: 133 miles



DAY 4: Meekoos/Vieux Moulin




