ARRIVE: La Malbaie

Arrive at the Trois Canards located in La Malbaie just outside Quebec City between 3-5 pm. After check-in you have some time to yourself to deal with any last minute concerns. We recommend removing your sled from your trailer. Meet and greet in lounge at 6pm followed by dinner as a group. Review of safety and security procedures.

Lodging: Trois Canards

DAY 1: La Malbaie/Ravage

Breakfast at the inn. If necessary, pick up any sled rentals next to hotel. Beautiful scenery and varied trails for the day. This area is mountainous with twisty trails. Early arrival at the spectacular Ravage, where great ambiance and a five course dinner await.

Lodging: Auberge Du Ravage Distance: 128 miles

DAY 2: Ravage/Les Escoumins

Breakfast. We head north to Petit Saguenay as we wind our way down to the ferry. We cross the ferry by sled and meet sweeping trails along Trail 3 to our destination.

Lodging: Hotel Pelchat Distance: 144 miles

DAY 3: Les Escoumais/Carcajou

Breakfast. A beautiful day of countryside views and fabulous trails. First part of the day will be on remote local trails with an off grid stop for lunch. Then we cross through the heart of Monts Valin and on to a great Auberge for the night. Lots of snow in this region.

Lodging: Auberge Carcajou Distance: 134 miles

DAY 4: Carcajou/Auberge Des Isles

Breakfast. Today we take some incredible local trails in the morning and stop at one of our favorite outifters for lunch in Lamarche. Onwards to Alma and then our hotel for the evening. This night's destination is set lakeside with beautiful views, and their signature specialty is duck and blueberry pasta. Lodging: Auberge Des Isles









DAY 5: Auberge Des Isles/La Malbaie


