ARRIVE: Saint-Michel-des-Saints, Quebec

Arrive at the Pourvoirie Kanamouche, located two hours north of Montreal between 3-5 pm. After check-in you have some time to yourself to deal with any last minute concerns. We recommend removing your sled from trailer upon arrival. Meet and greet in lounge at 6pm followed by dinner as a group. Review of safety and security procedures.

Lodging: Pourvoirie Kanamouche

DAY 1: Kanamouche/100 Lacs

Breakfast at the inn. If necessary, pick up any sled rentals. Trail winds around Lac Taureau for the first 20 miles. Lunch & fuel at Lac Repos before heading west. Dinner and lodging at an off-grid outfitter that is known for their specialty flank steak.

Lodging: Pourvoirie 100 Lacs

Distance: 170 miles

DAY 2: 100 Lacs/Rabaska

Breakfast. We head south on a regional trail. This is a fifty mile section of trail that is very picturesque. Lunch near Devils Mountain. We circle the mountain before stopping at Rabaska for lodging and dinner. Their dinner specialty is Walleye.

Lodging: Rabaska

Distance: 170 miles

DAY 3: Rabaska/Pourvoirie Mekoos

Breakfast. This day is spent in the beautiful nature of this area. Scenery can't get any better than this. Dinner and lodging is at the Pourvoirie Mekoos, a large outfitter situated on a lake with individual cabins for sleeping.

Lodging: Pourvoirie Mekoos

Distance: 140 miles

DAY 4: Mekoos/Kanamouche



